MISSIONS FOOD PANTRY COLLECTION

We provide donations to both the Ripon Area Food Pantry and the Ripon Community Food Pantry. The items you donate are divided between the two.



Suggested items for June are: Peanut Butter, jam and jelly; Canned tuna, chicken, salmon, stew; oatmeal; rice; pasta; pasta sauces; single serve cereals; canned fruits; dried fruits; instant potatoes; protein bars; crackers; Manwich style sauces; Hamburger Helper; Mac & Cheese; shelf-stable milk; flour; white sugar; brown sugar; condiments; salad dressings; cooking oil; pancake syrup; brownie and cake mix; biscuit mix. Thank you for your support of our local area food pantries!

PLASTIC FILM/BAG RECYCLING

We can see the donations to our bins growing nicely! Thank you so much, let's keep it going!

What you can bring: plastic grocery bags; bread bags; bubble wrap; newspaper sleeves; dry cleaning bags; ice bags; plastic shipping envelopes; re-closable food storage bags (Ziplock, etc.); beverage plastic case wrap; salt pellet bags; mulch bags; produce bags; etc.



School is over. So are school lunches.

For students living with food insecurity, Summer Break means one less meal that they can count on.

Community Food Pantry is heading up a program called **“Summer School Lunches”** that offers food for school children ages 5-18 in our community who are in need due to food insecurity at home.

Individual food bags will be given out at the Elementary schools, while the Middle and High schools will have a self-service food kiosk where students can pick out what they need.

Food donations needed at Community Food Pantry are:

Ages 5-12:

- Sturdy fresh fruits - apples; oranges; pears; mandarin oranges; etc.
- Easy access individual serving items like protein/granola bars; cereal cups; juice boxes; fruit snacks; corn cups; rice cups; etc.
- Shelf stable milk
- Crackers - peanut butter; cheese
- Non-Perishable protein - cheese sticks; meat sticks; beef jerky; etc.

Ages 13-18:

- All of Ages 5-12 list, plus:
- Mac & cheese cups; noodle cups; etc.
- Oatmeal packets
- Protein shakes
- Shelf stable microwavable meals

Ages 13-18 (who can walk, bike, etc.)

- \$15-\$20 food gift cards - Kwik Trip; fast food; Hy-Vee; Dollar Store; etc.
